Seasonal Advice

Here is some very practical and timely seasonal advice from Joe Stumpf

Well summer is here and the heat is turned up. Now is the time to be careful with watering. I water my trees about every other day. However, I noticed that of the trees that I use as indicators (i.e., they wilt in the afternoon) were still moist. Why would that be? Answer is they are not transpiring and actually go into a semi dormant state. So what does that mean? We could end up overwatering. If we just continue to water, the water lays at the bottom of the pot. Root rot could set in because of this condition. Our plant may need repotting if the soil has become compacted or the plant is root bound.

Also, look for signs of heat stress. If the soil is moist and the plant is wilting, especially in late afternoon, this is a sign the plant is stressed. You need to get it out of direct sun. Usually after sunset these plants will "perk up". Best to keep those plants in dappled sunlight or in shade for a few weeks.

Bottom line is check your plants. If the soil is wet, don't water. Misting the foliage or bench will help to cool thing down.
