May Recap


David's presentation on Mame bonsai was fantastic! Personally I know he inspired me to create some "cheap and cheerful" little trees.







May is a busy bonsai month with World Bonsai Day and the Annual BSF convention. There is lots for everyone to enjoy and it is an ideal month to celebrate our love for the trees.



Seasonal Advice

Now that June has started we are entering our rainy season with pop-up afternoon showers commonplace. Tropical trees will love this heat and humidity and their growth will kick into high gear. All of your tropical trees can now be repotted, pruned and worked on safely.

Make sure you stay on top your watering and give your trees a little extra attention on windy and hot days. Remember plants use water to cool themselves so even a short time drying out can damage a tree or significantly weaken it.

Some deciduous trees and broadleaf evergreens may appreciate a little afternoon shade, if possible. They can handle the summer sun but seem to stay happier with afternoon shade.

You can continue to prune tropical, broadleaf, and deciduous trees that are rapidly growing. The removal of branches will encourage new growth. For non-tropical I would suggest a lighter approach during the hottest months. Temperate trees are typically under more stress during high temperatures and that should be considered when pruning.
