Seasonal Advice

We were fortunate that the hurricane passed us by with little impacts. Hopefully everyone had an easy time putting their garden back to rights after the storm. It is never fun preparing for a major weather event. Now that it's over it might be a good time to clean things up you have been putting off.

Eagle eyed readers will notice that the seasonal advice below will look the same as last month. August & September car practices are very similar as we enter the tail end of summer.

- 1. Your plants might showing signs of heat stress. Stressed plants may benefit from some afternoon shade to reduce the need for transpiration cooling.
- 2. Heat and humidity is a breeding ground for fungal issues. Consider preventative treatment or treat at the first signs of an issue.
- 3. If you haven't already now is the time to repot your tropical trees and do any intensive work. Tropical trees prefer about 6 weeks of consistent night time temps over 60 degrees to fully recover from any major root work. Now is the time to take care of that work you have been putting off. Once we reach the

end of September the night time temperatures will moderate some and the ideal tropical repotting window will have passed.
